Podiatrists would enroll as an associate member which is a reduced annual membership plus a monthly monitoring fee. The MSDC-PHP is typically a five (5) year monitoring agreement that includes weekly randomized drug and alcohol testing plus if indicated 12-Step support groups, including Caduceus. Each participant (physician) is referred for an evaluation, which can be outpatient or inpatient, and the MSDC-PHP will incorporate those treatment recommendations into the MSDC-PHP contract with the participant.

The podiatry board was included in the revised protocol. We do sign contracts-for-service with each licensing board, however, we do not currently have one in place with the podiatry board. Previous talks indicated that funding was an issue at the time. However, we are looking to take on additional populations in need of our service, as there is such a great need for them in Maine in particular. We would like to sit down with the Board of Licensure of Podiatric Medicine to have a conversation, and gauge if they would be willing to revisit the idea of contracting with the MPHP. We are also open to providing a non-contracted, fee-for-service to these professionals in need. Our Oversight Committee recently (after this inquiry) approved working with DPM's but limited it to those referred by a hospital, or when we have the hospital involved. This is partly an issue of cost. Hospitals pay a fee to receive our services. It is also a risk management issue – in that someone is in a position to be aware of practice issues. Though I suspect that DPM's spend much more time in office than in hospitals. Adding new providers tends to be evolutionary. Small steps each time we began working with new groups – PA's, other allied health professionals – Vets and Chiropractors (with whom we have involvement and payment from their respective boards).

									We are under a contract with the Office of Professional Licensure and Certification to provide our services for physicians, physician assistants, dentists, pharmacists and veterinarians. NHPHP is a low budget nonprofit with 1.5 FTEs so we can't take on outside groups but we encourage all other licensed healthcare providers in the state to work with their Associations and Boards to request participation in NHPHP. Currently the licenses are charged approximately \$20 per license per year in the renewal fees which are paid to the NHPHP after we are accepted as the contractor through a RFP process. Licensees would pay for their treatment and appropriate drug testing but there is no charge for NHPHP case management. Our Board of Directors and Bylaws are set up that as many NH healthcare professional groups can be added as necessary. As numbers increased, so would the budget and staffing to cover the numbers. Our Board of Directors has approved the NHPHP contracting with individual licensees of non-covered Boards if there is a Board request for monitoring and we have been working with one such individual at present.
