We are under a contract with the Office of Professional Licensure and Certification to provide our services for physicians, physician assistants, dentists, pharmacists and veterinarians. NHPHP is a low budget nonprofit with 1.5 FTEs so we can't take on outside groups but we encourage all other licensed healthcare providers in the state to work with their Associations and Boards to request participation in NHPHP. Currently the licensees are charged approximately \$20 per license per year in the renewal fees which are paid to the NHPHP after we are accepted as the contractor through a RFP process. Licensees would pay for their treatment and appropriate drug testing but there is no charge for NHPHP case management. Our Board of Directors and Bylaws are set up that as many NH healthcare professional groups can be added as necessary. As numbers increased, so would the budget and staffing to cover the numbers.
